2	Would be better if the professor teaches at a slower pace.	
3	The tests are overall hard and I wish that we have more time to learn about what we're learning so we can get more of an understanding on the concept.	
4	The teacher was hard to follow	
5	The pace of the course was taken very fast	
6	The only thing I would suggest is maybe teaching the material in a different way, since I found myself and some of my friends in the class had a hard time learning just from class alone.	
7	Teacher only wanted to talk about engineering and nothing else. Also explained concepts poorly and did not give enough time to copy down the problems.	
8	Professor had no structure in his classes, no notes accessible outside of class, only wrote on the whiteboard and quickly erased. Did not allow students to take pictures but worked through problems extremely fast paced. He is very smart and it makes his pace of teaching too fast for students who are learning concepts for the first time. I appreciate his schedule that made it clear what each week consisted of, but wish his lessons were more planned out and gave actual notes instead of working through practice problems.	
9	My professor sometimes did a poor job of explaining topics or worked through them too quickly, mostly because I think he is just so used to going this math and doesn't understand what it is like to learn it for the first time.	
10	I would say that he does work in a fast pace and calculates a lot of things in his head.	
11	I think that going over the course material more slowly before doing the example problems would be very helpful as if you don't understand the concept, then no matter how many problems that you do, you don't know what your doing. I think that sometimes there are a lot of mental jumps in the discussion which is hard for someone with less math experience to follow.

15	I didn't like the teaching methods the professor used I wasn't able to understand any of the lessons he has no good teaching methods and no care for the students struggling.	
16	I didn't like how the lectures would be fast-paced and then I wouldn't be able to get all the notes down. Also, how we didn't get any notes uploaded to Canvas and given to us if we missed notes from the lecture, then he erased notes from white whiteboard when we might not have written everything down or at least taken a picture to get the rest. So maybe these few areas can be improved. However, the professor is a pretty honest, nice, and straightforward guy during class and his methods are good it just might be difficult to keep up with him at times, especially for a disability student like me. Also, homework didn't show steps on how to solve problems if you were stuck on one.

1	When he solves the problems, he often calculates everuthing in his mind and doesn't really explain exactly what he is doing and does not offer office hours.	
2	What I dislike about Professor England is that sometimes he went too fast over the material or problems which caused him to make mistakes.

4	The instructor makes a lot of mistakes when solving questions, he always quickly fixes those mistakes but it is not a good image to see your professor making that many mistakes.
