I would like the class to be taught more straight forward and for example problems to be ones that are going to be on the test.

I found myself having to invest in ASU online videos, and youtube videos to be successful. Professor England was often condescending towards us when asking questions, our class sessions were random and he would never take time to discuss what we would be going over. Rather he would just jump into examples concerning the concept but with no detail for us to learn it.</p> <p>On several occasions I remember being so lost and confused that I would ask a question and Professor England would belittle me or question if I had been coming to class or paying attention.</p> <p>8 Professor England would also always show up to classes unmotivated to teach us or show any bit of enthusiasm for the subject. How do you expect students to come into class excited, ready and eager to learn when you can't? I am EXTREMELY DISAPPOINTED that ASU wasted my money on this class because the only thing they provided was a structured regiment of concepts that I HAD TO LEARN ON MY OWN. Who gives a shit if we are #1 in innovation when ASU can't provide at least decent instructors.</p> <p>I am sorry to be blunt, but it absolutely terrifies me that he will be teaching courses next semester to new students and I wish the absolute best for each of them.</p> <p>I know Professor England has much going in his personal life and I am truly sorry to hear about everything he is dealing with. Maybe this is the reason for how this semester went, or maybe not. But I strongly recommend that ASU looks into this teacher.</p>

1	he's terrible seriously. when i have more time, i will be reporting him to the dean		
2	almost everything, he is oftentimes rude to students and for me is not effective in showing how to do something merely doing a problem and expecting us to follow what he is doing		
3	Very unorganized, unprepared, and belittles students when they ask a simple question or a question that has already been asked.		
4	The professor moves too fast and does not seem able to explain the material in a simple way. What appears complex when he does it, is actually very simple once I learn the material on my on after. He is extremely rude when responding to emails and- even though he will say otherwise- does not seem to care about helping his students succeed.		
5	The professor was absolutely horrid. He was unprepared every class, spent the first 20-30 minutes of every class complaining about us or some other aspect of his life. Examples that he would try and demonstrate for us were often wrong and ended with him saying "Oh, well, it's wrong, but you guys get it." Or "This is too hard, but you guys can do it." Speaking with other students, I, along with others, were afraid of approaching the professor.		

6	The lectures were very unorganized and not thought out. I suggest that the instructor should be more in depth when explaining concepts as well as showing all the steps to solving a problem rather than skipping the most important steps.	
7	The instructor was very vague and quick when explaining a topic. If you didn't understand a topic, he would criticize and talk down to the student if they didn't understand. It discouraged me and other students from asking for help, which is why during the 2-hour lectures almost no student would ever speak.

9	Online learning. I hate online learning.	
10	Like I said before he can be mean but it's understandable with people repeating questions at times.	
11	I wrote my thoughts about professor England in the course session. Overall, ASU needs to really examine him.	
12	I was terrified of him(might just be my fear of teachers tho) and he went VERY fast. could also be that i was just stupid	
13	I think that class discussion and collaboration should be encouraged in the classroom to help us prepare for exams.	
14	I liked all of it. The only improvement I would suggest is to maybe spend a little time with the Trig identities because they popped up a lot and I know I needed a refresher on them.	
15	I just didn't like the way he taught the class. While there were examples, the problems weren't going to be ones on the test and we spent a lot of the class not talking about math. I was also really confused on content because of the way the class was taught.	
16	I have no suggestions.	
17	I disliked his methodology for carrying out his lectures, partly since it did not fit well with the online format that was necessary to implement for the class.	
18	His teaching could be executed more effectively, especially when providing the basic information. His examples are sometimes too difficult and not necessary, making it hard to understand.	
19	He would mention cigarettes every 20 minutes, he would sometimes not answer questions students had, he didn't teach that well.	
20	He was fast and rude when students asked questions, condescending.	
21	He was condescending, rudely blunt, and confusing with examples.	
22	He rarely connected with any students. Gave none to one example for each concept and gave basic overviews. A lot of self teaching on every topic was needed. Got mad when you asked questions. Never was helpful for questions.	
23	He is rude to students, hardly teaches the concepts only goes over practice problems very quickly. My suggestions for him are either find a way to enjoy your job and teach effectively or find a new job.	
24	He didn't hold office hours, so communication was either through email or piazza. He didn't have a slideshow, so I couldn't really understand the concept very well, since his instruction was primarily verbal. Also, he went very fast, so it was hard to keep up with the material, despite him pacing the concepts/topics well.	
25	Everything, I had to teach myself this entire course. He does not provide clear instructions.	
26	Class lectures were unstructured and the pace during the lectures was too fast. Condescending to students when asking for help. Homework assigned was not directly related to exams. Class averages on exams were low and no curve was applied. Announcements sent in Canvas often did not apply and created confusion which the instructor would not take responsibility for. I do not feel the class has adequately prepared me for higher level classes in the future.	
27	As with the class structure the professor was disorganized in his method of teaching and was often so sarcastically harsh that it gave off the impression that he was unapproachable. However, I do believe that outside of the pandemic things would've been slightly better.
