2	The pace seems to be a little extreme for the content covered. I feel like this course could be extended like my physics course to give a slight increase in time to cover so much content.	
3	The class lessons are not comprehensive at all. The video example problems skip too many steps. The problems that we get on homework and exams are sometimes not found in lessons. About 90% of material that I used in order to pass the class I had to find on my own from outside videos and lessons. Also, unfair how 90% of the grade falls in tests. Someone could not do any homework and still get an A in class. Also, 2 tests out of 3 had to be extended because the instructor has issues working with Canvas/Webwork.	
4	Test prep does not match the online course. In person class is different set of questions and therefore different prep.	
5	Some of the video lectures were hard to follow	
6	It it not the course but the amount of time to learn all lessons.	
7	Instructors were very fast.	
8	I felt the timing of the tests was very odd. With this being a summer session we were going through the material pretty quickly - but the tests were timed such that we were several sections beyond the material that was on the test by the time we took it. I found myself having to do lectures/homework of material well past what was on the exam the day before - then having to go back and reset to old material for the test. There was also a lot of confusion and technical issues on when the test was open to be taken. The course calendar didn't line up to the syllabus, and even adjustments to the test time by the instructor didn't work out correctly.
